These are emigrants that have not been identified from obituaries, letters and articles in newspapers collected in the Rowberg files:

Family 245: Mrs. Peder Skarpness, b. March 1, 1872 ? in Hadeland, d. July 10, 1946 in New Rockford, ND. She was survived by her husband and 2 daughters; Mrs. Everett Sherman in Seattle, WA and Mrs. John Dodds in New Rockford. Living siblings; Edward Haugen in Butte, ND; Halvor Haugen in Hadeland; Mrs. Lars Solli in Petersburg, ND and Mrs. Helen Monge at Broadway,?? (*From Normanden*, July 18, 1946)

Family 246: Peder Steen, died Oct. 5, 1929, 33 years old, born in Hadeland and emigr. 1916. He was a veteran from WWI and a member of Kringen 25, Fargo, ND He is survived by his wife, a sister and two brothers in Norway. (*Sons of Norway*, Dec. 1929)

Family 247: Anders E. Thoen, died in Bedford, ?? 85 years old. He emigrated from Hadeland about 1910 and lived in Bedford for 58 years. He was a glassblower, and worked in Gundersen Glassworks for 50 years. He retired when he was 80. (*Decorah Posten*, May 29, 1967)

Family 248: Mrs. George Thomas (Enga) ,Augusta, WI, wants to hear from others from Jevnaker. She was happy that Ike came back in Washington! (Article in *Decorah Posten*, 1957)

Family 249: Hans Tingelstad, July 20, 1844 in Norway, died in the home of his daughter, Mrs. Gilbert Olson in Pelican Rapids, MN, 84 years old? He came to US in 1866, his wife died in 1897. 12 children, these were alive: Anna Thingelstad, Pelican Rapids; Mrs. Louis Fredrickson, Brainerd; Mrs. Bertha Paulson, Detroit; Mrs. Oscar Paulson, Baliur, ND; Mrs. Gilbert Olson, Norwegian Grove; Hans and Anton Tingelstad in Bisbeen, ND. He was buried at Gran Church in Clay Co., MN. (*Skandinaven*, Jan. 27, 1926)

Family 250: Hans Vindom, b. Jan. 21, 1853? in Gran, Hadeland, emigrated when 11 years old. Mar. Dec. 14, 1873, his wife was born Jan. 10, 1854 in US by Norwegian parents. In 1900 they settled in Turtle Mountain, ND. 8 children, 3 had died in 1934. 4 daughters were married and lived in ND, the son lived at home. Hans and his wife celebrated 60th wedding anniversary in 1933. (Mrs. Ole H. Larshus in *Decorah Posten*, Jan. 2, 1934)

Family 251: Mr. and Mrs. Hans Vostad celebrated golden wedding in the Lutheran Church inVolga, SD, where they have lived since 1906. Mrs. Vostad was born in Hadeland and came to Argyle, WI in 1874. Hans Vostad was born in Vardal, Oppland ,Norway and came to Vade, IA in 1880. They have 7 sons and 2 daughters. (*Skandinaven*, May 14, 1937)

Family 252: Mrs. Pauline Bloomingdale died Oct. 9, 1935 in her home at East Broadway, Decorah, IA. She was born Paulina Pedersen in Hadeland Feb. 16, 1860?

She emigrated in 1868 to Winneshiek Co., IA where she lived on the family farm until 2 years ago, when she moved to her daughter Mrs. Alfred Weiss in Decorah. She was first married Aug. 4, 1890 to A.B. Anderson, and then to W.W. Bloomingdale Aug. 14, 1905. Children: Andrew in Decorah; Beme in Sheldon, WI; Lillie (Mrs. Alfred Weiss). One son, Engel died as an infant. She had 5 step-children. Buried at Decorah Lutheran Cemetery. (*Decorah Posten*, Oct. 15, 1935)

Family 253: Petter O. Westby and his wife from Jamestown, ND went on a trip to Norway in April with "Stavangerfjord." It is 50 years since they have been to Norway. They will be 3 months on the trip, and will also visit Sweden and Denmark. P.O. Westby has worked 50 years for Northern Pacific Railroad, the last 40 years as a conductor. They are both from Hadeland. Mr. Westby has 4 brothers and 2 sisters in Norway, Mrs. Westby has 2 brothers there. From 1954 to 1956 Mr. Westby was president of 4th District Lodge, Sons of Norway. (*Nordiske Tidende*, May 12, 1960)

Family 254: Mrs. Gilbert Winger, (Bertha Skiaker), born Jan. 23, 1860? in Norway. She came to Walcott, ND in 1894 and married Gilbert the same year. He died in 1920. She has lived in Walcott for 50 years, and died in her farm home. Children: Sigurd and Signe in Walcott. (No newspaper record, but it must be from the 1940s)

Family 255: Mrs. Christina Winger died March 19, buried at Appleton Cemetery, MN. She was born in Feb. 1854, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Christian Jacobsen from Hadeland. She came first to Fergus Falls, MN and married Thomas Winger, Sept. 7, 1882. Lived in Louisburg until 1909, then they moved to ND. From 1912 in Appleton. Thomas died in Feb. 1923. They had 15 children, 8 are living: Minnie (Mrs. Harry Harkness) in Tacoma, WA; Martha (Mrs. C.L. Stromen) in Appleton; Jennie (Mrs. John Rooney) in Tacoma; Andrew in Venice, CA; Oscar in Spokane, WA; Thomas in Orchard, WA; Ole and Peter in Appleton. (*Appleton Press*, MN, March 24, 1944).

Family 256: Alf Hole (Hoel?) b. Jan. 24, 1910? in Jevnaker, died Jan. 6, 1967 in Brooklyn, New York. Buried Jan. 10, at Greenfield Cemetery, Hempstead, 1.1. Thanks very much for all sympathy from Harald, Einar and Johan Hoel, Mrs. Tonny Anderson and brothers and sisters in Norway. (could not read the newspaper's name)

Family 257: Mrs. Albert Anderson, from Devils Lake, ND, was in Norway in 1957. She is from Hadeland and was in Norway also 10 years ago. She has 5 sisters and 3 brothers in Norway, and visited her sisters at Jaren in Gran. Together with factory owner, Harald Scherven and wife, she had a tour up in the mountains. (*Decorah Posten*, May 13, 1958)

Family 258: Letter in Decorah Posten from Mrs. Ragnhild Nelson, Burnham, Sask., Canada: "I came from Brandbu in 1929. it was so nice to see a letter in 'Posten' from Marie Bratnow, who also came from Brandbu, so bad we live so far from each other. Thank you very much for all the interesting stuff in this newspaper; 'Ola and Per,' all news from the war, and the letters from the readers." (*Decorah Posten*, July 6, 1944)

Family 259: Ole Olavson, from Joel, WI?? has died, 80 years old. He was born in Hadeland, Norway. (*Skandinaven*, Nov. 14, 1939)

Family 260: Mrs. Sarah Olson, died 83 years old, buried at Crystal Lake Cemetery,

Minneapolis. She was born Sigrid Steen in Hadeland, and has lived in Minneapolis for 52 years. 2 children, Dagny Olson and Victor, one sister, Mrs. Gust Johnson, all in Minneapolis. This can be Siri Iversdtr., b. Nov. 21, 1855 at Kjoseiet ? (*Skandinaven*, Feb. 22, 1938)

Family 261: Mrs. Marie Engelhart Pederson, b. Feb. 18, 1868 in Hadeland, emigrated 1891, married 1892 in Madison, MN to Engelhart Pederson who died near Greenbush, MN in 1916. Marie died Aug. 9, 1947 in Fargo, ND? Children: 2 sons and 6 daughters. This can be Marie Hansdtr., b. Feb. 19, 1868 in Ryaengen in Lunner. (*Lutheranen*, Sept. 17, 1947)

Family 262: Letter from Ole E. Pederson: My father Engebret Molbakken or Brørby came from Hadeland about 1862 to Prairie du Chien, WI. Later to McGregor, IA where he married Oline Dalrud. They settled in Chippewa Co., MN, near Montevideo. I'm their son. They died when I was young. Is there anybody who knew them? (*Decorah Posten*, July 31, 1952)

Family 263: Letter from Peder Pederson in Mayville, ND: My parents, Iver and Martha Pederson were from Hadeland and came here about 30 years ago. I have worked in a clothing store since I was 15, and then started a store in Mayville, 5 years ago, under the name, "Moren & Pederson." We have clothing for men, women and children. (*Fram*, Jul. 20, 1916)

Family 264: Letter from Mrs. Helma Peper, Wanderoos, WI: My father was born in Lysenstøa in Gran. (Who is her father?) My first cousin and I have corresponded some years ago. Another first cousin was killed in Norway during the war. I'm so happy that my daughter in Minneapolis pays for "Posten" for me. Happy New Year to our loved newspaper. (*Decorah Posten*, Jan. 19, 1956)

Family 265: Letter from Mrs. Lewis Peterson, Box 303, Taylor, WI: I was born Marie Bjørklund or Rullandhaug, I'm 75 years old and came here 50 years ago. I have been married 47 years, have 3 children. This fall I visited Mari and Caroline Lere fra Røykenvik, they live 274 miles from here. I haven't seen them for 50 years. It was fun to see my friends from my young days in Hadeland. (*Decorah Posten*, Dec. 8, 1955)

Family 266, form 450: Torgrim Olsen, b. 1811 in Putten on the west side of Randsfjorden, emigr. 1869 with wife Gudbjør Johnsdtr., b. 1819 in Bukjernseteren, son Johannes, b. Aug. 5, 1854 in Eidsbraaten and adopted daughter Kari Olsdtr., b. 1861. Also their son Ole b. Feb. 1842, may have emigrated. Torgrim's brother, Ole, settled in Freeborn Co., MN, later in Winnebago Co., IA. We have no info about Torgrim and his family.

Family 267, form 451: Halvor Jensen Flatla, b. Dec. 27, 1874 in Lunner, emigr. 1896, married to Julia Hoim in 1912, lived in McHenry Co., ND, missing records about children and death. His uncle, Halvor Olsen, b. Feb. 2, 1850 at Flatla, emigr. 1909 to ND, no information.

Family 268, form 452: Lage Iversen, b. 1800 at Halvorsrud in Jevnaker, married 1834 to Berte Hansdtr.. b. 1811 on Rya in Lunner. They emigr. 1854 from Tronrud in Jevnaker with children: Marte, b. Jan. 18, 1837, Hans, b. Jun. 15, 1839, Iver, b. Dec. 25, 1842 and Gjertrud. b. June 13, 1848. No information.

Family 269, form 453: Anne Gudbrandsdtr., b. Nov. 17, 1875 at Helgeland in Lunner, emigr. 1902. Lived in Ruso, McHenry Co., ND. Married to Albert Kantrud, 7 children, no information about children and death dates. Anne's siblings in US, all born at Helgeland: 1. Karen Marie, b. Dec. 1, 1868, emigr. 1893, married Johannes Thompson; 2. Jørgen, b. Jan. 16, 1871, emigr. 1893; 3. Anders, b. Feb. 22, 1873, emigr. 1896, was back in 1905 and emigr. again with his later wife, Elise Pedersdtr., b. Oct. 26, 1879 at Hallum in Lunner. They also lived in Ruso. 4. Peder, b. Feb. 9, 1878, emigr. 1900, 5. Hilda, b. Feb. 9, 1883, emigr. 1907. We are missing much info about them all, see Form 453.

Family 270, form 454: Jacob Jacobsen, b. Oct. 5, 1869 at Lynneeiet in Gran, emigr. 1890 to New York. Married in Bond, MN to Anna Austad. One daughter? who married Allen Alexander in Cold Springs, MN. Jacob died Oct. 14, 1948 in ? He had 3 brothers who emigrated: 1. Gudbrand, b. Feb. 25, 1854 at Helgakereiet in Gran, farmer near Montevideo?; 2. Iver, b. Nov. 21, 1862, emigrated 1884 to Montevideo; 3. Christen (Christen Lynne), b. Sept. 14, 1865, d. June 16, 1956 in McLean Co., ND, see Form 433.

Family 271, form 462: Ole Olsen (Rollin Olson), b. 1831 at Kalnebbrud (Gunstadeiet) in Jevnaker, emigr. 1849, married 1854 to Maren Pedersdtr., b. 1837, emigr. 1852. We have information about them. They are both buried in Jordan, Green Co., WI. Maren's mother, Maren Hansdtr., b. 1806, also emigrated in 1852 with children: Torsten, b. May 11, 1832; Hans, b. Oct. 2, 1833; Anders, b. Dec. 11, 1840; Randi, b. March 9, 1843 and Petrine Mathea, b. March 6, 1846. The only information we have is for Petrine Mathea, who married Anders Johnson, b. July 12, 1839 in Brandbu. He was in the Civil War and was a prisoner in Andersonville for 16 months. Later they were farmers in Browntown, WI. We have records for their children, but no death records. Anders Johnsen's siblings in America: 1. Helene, b. Aug. 1, 1825, see Form 81; 2. Hans (Henry?), b. Sept. 10, 1827 in Brandbu, married 1853 with Karen Hansdtr., b. Jun. 24, 1828 in Tingelstad, emigr. before 1865 with children: Anne, b. Aug. 13, 1854; Jørgine, b. Dec. 26, 1859 and Jnlrn, b. May, 6, 1863 in Brandbu. After the death of Karen, Hans married a Jørgina Gilbertson. Missing many records for this family.

Family 272, form 465: Hans Olsen, (brother of Ole Rollin Olsen), b. July 28, 1820 at Gunstadeiet in Jevnaker, emigr. with wife Marthe Gulbrandsdtr., b. April 8, 1819 in Jevnaker and children: Oline, b. June 30, 1847; Kari, b. June 1, 1850; Anders, b. June 28, 1853 and Iver, b. Oct. 1,

1856. Oline married a Berger Johnson, Karl married 1872 to Jørgen Lilleberg, b. 1841 in Trøndelag. They settled in Ervin Twp., Traill Co., ND in 1878. Anders married Johanne Johnsdtr., see Form 890. Missing death records for all of them.

Family 273, form 466: Hans Olsen Hagen, b. 1822 at Røkeneiet in Brandbu, emigr. 1862 with wife Siri Andersdtr, b. 1826 at Strandeeiet in W. Brandbu and children: Ole, b. Sept. 22, 1849; Birthe, b. Nov. 27, 1854; Anders, b. Oct. 10, 1856; John, b. April 15, 1860. They were farmers in Glenwood, Allamakee Co., IA, where they died. Ole was married to an Ingeborg, and d. 1902 in Northwood, ND, Birthe was married to Anders Olsen Vikne and d. 1899 in Northwood. Missing info about Anders and John. Siri's sister, Berthe Andersdtr., b. Jul. 25, 1823, emigr. 1862 with her husband, Lars Hansen. b. Nov. 4, 1827 at Blegeneiet in Brandbu, and children; Anders, b. Oct. 28, 1853; ~ b. Sept. 14, 1855 and Ingeborg, b. Sept. 2, 1859. No info about them. Siri's sister, Marthe Andersdtr., also emigr. 1862 with husband Hans Gudbrandsen and children: Gudbrand and Anders. They also settled in Allamakee Co., IA, see Form 257.

Family 274, form 469: Kari Gudbrandsdtr. Gammelseteren, b. Dec. 8, 1830 in Eidsbraaten on the West side of Randsijorden, emigr. 1875 from Tingelstad as a widow with her children: Anne, b. June 3, 1856; Andrine, b. Mar. 23, 1858; Johanne, b. Dec. 18, 1859; Elina, b. Jan. 24, 1862; John, b. Jan. 23, 1864; Anders, b. Feb. 27, 1866; Ole, b. Feb. 20, 1868; Gudbrand, b. April 22, 1870 and Caroline, b. Sept. 7, 1872, all born at Østenbrænden in Tingelstad. Their father, Johan Johnsen, had died 1874. Kari died about 1918 in ? When Andrine (Mrs. Andrenah Olson), died in April 1940, her children were Mrs. Ida R. Thonen in St. Paul and Mrs. P.K. Sveeggen in Minneapolis. Andrine's siblings in 1940 were: Gilbert Brenden in Badger, MN, Mrs. A.L. Thompson in Mahonmen, MN; Mrs. O.D. Wall and Mrs. David Heron in Albert Lea, MN. Kari's siblings from Gammelseteren: Ole, see #455; Kjersti, see #559; Erik, see #468; Christian, see #470 and Hans, see #958.

Family 275, form 470: Christian Gudbrandsen Gammelseteren, b. Jul. 22, 1828 at Saltbo at Bjoneskogen, emigr. 1869 with wife Gudbjør Pedersdtr., b. Feb. 2, 1829 at Bjoneskogen and children: Anne, b. May 20, 1858 and Peder, b. Aug. 1, 1864. Also Gudbjør's parents, Peder Pedersen, b. 1792 and Ingeborg Gulbrandsdtr., b. 1792 emigrated. No information about them. Gudbjør's siblings who emigrated: 1. Peder, b. May, 30, 1832 at Holmen at Bjoneskogen, emigr. 1867 with wife Oleana Olsdtr., b. about 1829 in Land and children: Ingeborg Maria, b. 1857; Anne, b. 1859; Peder, b. 1861; Olava, b. 1863 and Christine, b. 1865. 2. Ingeborg, b. Feb. 1, 1835 at Holmen, emigr. 1869 with husband Erik Larsen, b. Aug. 8, 1839 at Stensrudseiet at Bjoneskogen and daughter Lise, b. Dec. 19, 1867. We have no information about where they settled, the children's marriage or death records.

Family 276, form 479: Lars Olsen Ohe, b. 1814, emigr. 1869 with wife Ingeborg Torgersdtr. Vaterud, b. 1815, and 4 children. We have info about them. Lars Ohe's siblings in US: 1. Maren, b. Feb. 14, 1812, married 1841 to Iver Bemtsen, b. ? Don't know if they emigrated. 2. Amund, b. 1818 at Ohe, emigrated 1879 with wife Maren Hansdtr., b. 1822 in S. Land, Amund d. 1904 and Maren d. 1910, both in Rothsay, MN. They had many children: a) Ole, b. 1844, 1911 in Wilkin Co., MN, emigr. 1869, married 1873 to Guline Olsdtr., b. 1848, d. 1939 in Wilkin. Have their children's names, but missing records about them. b) Marthe, b. Jan. 27, 1847, emigrated 1881 with children: Anne Jørgine, b. Oct. 2, 1874; Anton, b. Dec. 1, 1876; Jacob, b. Jun. 19, 1879. Marthe's husband, Ole Jacobsen, b. Dec. 19, 1853 at Røkeneiet in Brandbu must have emigrated earlier. No info about them. c) Karen, b. Aug. 3, 1849 at Grymyreiet, emigr. 1878 with husband Peder Henriksen, b. Dec. 25, 1848 at Grymyreiet. In 1936 their children were: Mrs. Mary Severson in Lansing, IA; Albert Olaus Hendrickson on a farm southeast of Waukon and Peter Cornelius Hendrickson, whom the father Peder was staying with. No more info. d) Hans,

b. May 11, 1852, emigrated 1880 to Rothsay with wife Kari Larsdtr., b. Feb. 10, 1850 at Bildeneiet. No info. e) Anders, b. Dec. 23, 1854, emigrated 1880., no info. 11 Maren, b. Sept. 24, 1859, may also have emigrated, no info. g) Andreas, b. May 28, 1862, emigr. 1880, no info. h) Tilla, b. Dec. 26, 1866, emigr. 1880 to Rothsay, no info. 3. Gudbrand, b. Sept. 19, 1823 at Ohe, emigr. 1876 with wife Maren Toregersdtr., b. Dec. 12, 1816 at Lundeeiet in Gran, no info. Their children: a) Torger, b. June 19, 1846, emigr. ?; b) Christian, b. Dec. 12, 1849, emigrated 1874; c) Karine, b. May 28, 1854, emigr. 1877 with husband Christian Edv. Johannessen, b. May 22, 1853 at V. Toten and sons: Johan, b. Aug. 8, 1874 and Gulbrand, b. Nov. 2, 1876, no info.; d) Thorine, b. Sept. 18, 1857, emigrated? e) Hans Andreas, b. Nov. 19, 1860, emigrated with his parents in 1876, no info.

Family 277, form 487: Ole Gulbrandsen Falla, b. 1806 at Sogn in Jevnaker, emigr. 1868 with wife Berte Borgersdtr., b. 1807 at Jorstadeiet in Gran and daughter Man, b. Feb. 12, 1845. They first lived in Clermont, IA, no more info.

Their son, 1. Jens Plomason, b. Feb. 27, 1839, emigrated? (no date) with his wife Kirstine Christensdatter, b. 1840 in Modum in Buskerud, and son, Olavus (Ole), b. Jan. 1864. Jens lived first in Iowa, later he was a farmer in Mound Twp., Rock Co., MN. Children born in the U.S.: Stine M., b. 1873 in IA; Berthe H., b. 1876 and Hilda P., b. 1878, both in MN. No more info.

Son 2. Anders Plomason, b. June 10, 1848, emigrated 1868, have information about him. He died 1889 in Laveme, MN.

Family 278, form 489: Maren Pedersdtr., b. Feb. 14, 1818 at Rækken in Tingelstad, emigrated as widow in 1871 with children:

Ole b. Oct. 25, 1856, Maria. b. Sept. 2, 1859 and Lise, b. Feb. 4, 1865, all b. at Dynnaeiet in Gran. Maren died Feb. 8, 1902 in Northwood, ND, no info, about the children. The father was Amund Carlsen, died 1866.

Maren and Amund's other children:

1. Marthe, b. Mar. 26, 1839 at Vøien in Gran, emigrated 1870 with husband Erik Olsen, b. Jan. 6, 1834 at Godli in Lunner and daughter Anne, b. Apr 28, 1866, no information from the U.S.
2. Lars, b. Apr. 9, 1846 at Vøien, emigrated 1868, have information, see forms 489 and 342.
3. Peder, b. Sept. 5, 1848 at Dynnaeiet, emigrated 1870, have information, see form 489.
4. Karen, b. Sept. 22, 1853, emigrated 1872, have information, see form 199.

Family 279, form 492: Anders Arnesen, b. July 7, 1833 at Rækstadeiet in Tingelstad, emigrated 1883 from Avkjærnslien in West Brandbu with wife Marthe Paulsdatter, b. Jan. 18, 1840 at Næsbakken in Brandbu and children: 3. Marthea, b. Aug. 1, 1866; 4. Helene, b. May 18, 1870; 5. Edvard, b. Oct. 10, 1873; 6. Ole. b. March 4, 1877; and 7. Karen. b. May 10, 1879. No information about them.

Anders and Marthe's children:

1. Anne, b. Dec. 12, 1859, emigrated 1880, no information.
2. Paul, b. Mar. 28, 1863, emigrated 1881. We have information about his marriage and children. He died 1936 in Richiand Co., WI.

Family 280, form 493: Peder Jensen, b. Apr. 20, 1834 at Dæhleneiet in Brandbu, emigrated 1890. His wife, Mari Eriksdatter, b. Dec. 4, 1834 at Framastadeiet in Gran, emigrated 1891 with children: Mari. b. Sept. 17, 1877, Marthe, b. Sept. 17, 1877 and Siri, b. Nov. 5, 1879. They first lived in Delevan, Faribault Co., MN, then in Northwood, ND where Peder d. Sept. 5, 1910 and Mari d. about 1918. We are missing information about many of their children and grandchildren in the U.S.:

2. Erik Pedersen and his wife Kari Nilsdatter, stayed in Hadeland, but they had several children who emigrated:

- a) Peder, b. Nov. 25, 1877, emigrated 1901, no information;
- b) Nils, b. Dec. 9, 1880, emigrated 1901, no information;
- c) Anna Karoline, b. Nov. 3, 1888, emigrated 1905, no information;
- f) Emil, b. Dec. 19, 1894, emigrated 1914, no information.

3. Johan Pedersen, b. Dec. 19, 1859, emigrated 1882, died in Minot, ND, no more information.
4. Lars Pedersen. b. Dec. 8, 1861, emigrated 1885 with wife Kari Christensdtr.. b. Sept. 17, 1863 in Framstadhagen in Gran and their son, Kristian. b. July 8, 1884 at Saugseiet in Gran. They lived in Delevan, MN. Kari d. Mar. 10, 1916 and Lars married the second time in 1921 to

Alice M. Burgham. 6. Karl Peter, b. Jan. 4, 1866, emigrated 1888. Married to a Christine Caroline, b. Nov. 15, 1869. No information about children. Karl P. d. Oct. 18, 1954 in Emmett, WA, Christine d. March 12, 1927.

7. Syver, b. Jan. 1, 1869, left his wife and children in Jevnaker in 1893. He died in Canada?

8. Marius, b. Jan. 7, 1870, emigrated? He died in Montevideo, MN, no date or other information.

9. Lina. b. Oct. 11, 1871, emigrated 1891, married 1891 to a Gilbert Hanson, b. 1861, d. Apr. 30, 1949 in Northwood, ND. When Lina died May 8, 1956 in Northwood, her children were: Henry, Albert and Francis in Northwood; Petter in Hatton, ND; Mrs. Gustav Larson in Northwood; Mrs. Martin Bjerke and Mrs. A.C. Olson in Portland, OR; Mrs. F.W. Holz in Auburn, WA; Mrs. Leon Lee in Seattle, WA; Mrs. J.J. Halvorson in Grand Forks, ND) and Mrs. GM. Sime in Gilby, ND. No records for the children.

12. Iver, b. Feb. 10, 1876, died? in Canada.

13. Mari, see above, no information.

14. Marthe (Mrs. Andrews), see above, d. Feb. 27, 1960 in Delevan, MN. 15. Sin. (Mrs. Howards), see above, d. in Nappa, CA, no other records.

Peder Jensen had 3 brothers who emigrated, see forms 810 and 804. Mari Eriksdatter had 7 siblings who emigrated, see form 493. Missing information about many of them.

Family 281, form 496: Peder Paulsen, b. Jan. 1., 1819 at Skiaker in Giran, emigrated 1849, died 1905 in Hartland, MN. Peder was not married, and sold his farm in Hartland to his niece, Marthe Juelsdatter, b. Nov. 11, 1849 at Morstad in Gran who emigrated 1869 with husband, Anders Larsen Løkenhagen, b. Sept. 1, 1846 at Morstadeiet. Children: Peter, (1869-1938); Ida, (1872-?); Leonard, (1874-?); Pearly A., (1877-?); Catinker, (1879-?), b. in Hartland; Jake (1887-?), b. in SD? We are missing death records for Marthe and Anders. Marthe Juelsdatter had 2 brothers who emigrated: Paul Juelsen, b. Dec. 6, 1851, d. Apr. 5, 1916 in Miner Co., SD and Peder Juelsen b. Dec. 27., 1853, d. 1921 in Sioux Falls, SD.

Anders Larsen's brother Erik, b. Oct. 9, 1837 at Hvalseiet in Gran and his wife Ingeborg Johannesdatter, b. May 3, 1847 at Flatlaeiet in Lunner, must have emigrated before 1875. No information about them, but their two children, Marthea. b. Feb. 27, 1867 and Johan, b. Mar. 11, 1871 emigrated .188.6 to Albert Lea, MN. No records about Johan, but Marthea married a Mr. Samuelson and had 4 children: Inger and Morris who died before 1971 and Mrs. Ida Self and Ms. Torena Samuelson who lived in Minot, ND. Sept. 20, 1819 in Gudmundshagen in Tingelstad and children: Johannes, b. June 18, 1853; Peder, b. Oct. 11, 1855; Kirsti. b. Aug.11, 1858 and Brede, b. July 16, 1862. No information about them. Ingeborg's sister, Kari, b. Dec. 30, 1821, d. Aug. 10, 1906 in Fillmore Co., MN, see form 876.

Family 283, form 498: Paul Johnsen Viker, b. July 5, 1835 at Askimeiet in Tingelstad, emigrated 1882 to Fergus Falls, MN with wife Susanne Pedersdatter. b. June 22, 1840 at Hvindeneiet in Gran, and 5 children. The two oldest children emigrated 1883. Paul died 1930 in Fargo, ND, Susanne died 1902 in Fergus Falls, MN. Missing information about the children: 1. Anne. b. March 30, 1862, married 1886 to Martinius Andersen Holte. They were farmers in Mc Henry Co., ND and we have records for them and their children; 2. Kirsti (Mrs. Anderson). b. April 13, 1864, lived in Alberta Canada in 1922, missing information; 3. Marthe Maria (Mrs. Thompson), b. Oct. 14, 1866, lived in Alberta in 1922; 4. Ingeborg, b. June 20, 1871, no information; 5. Sophie (Mrs. Johnson), b. Apr. 1.1, 1874, lived in Alberta in 1922; 6. Pauline (Mrs. Gunder Sætran), b. Mar. 2, 1877; have their children's names. They lived in McHenry Co. from 1908. No death records. 7. Johan.Peder, b. June 13, 1880, no records.

Family 284, form 502: Nils Olsen Gjerdingen, b. July 8, 1824 at Hvattumseiet in Gran, emigrated 1868 with wife Valborg Olsdtr., b. Nov. 24, 1824 at Framstadtangen and 6 children. They settled in Spring Grove, MN. Missing information about their 4 youngest children: 4. Ragnhild Maria, b. July 4, 1857, no information; 5. Marthe. b. Aug. 13, 1859, married 1881 in Fargo to Peter E. Benson, missing records for children and deaths; 6. Kirsti, b. Dec. 2, 1861, married 1887 in Spring Grove to Iver Olsen Mybren, no information; 7. Hans, b. Feb. 22, 1864, married Jørgine Dokken, 2. married to Lise Dokken, Hans died? in Halstad, MN. no more information.

Oct. 10, 1851 and Ingeborg, b. May 31, 1854, both at Kjoseiet. They settled in Spring Grove, MN. Kari died Oct. 26, 1886, no death record for Borger. The son, Brede, lived in Davenport, ND, no other records. Ingeborg married 1878 to Andrew Gilbertson Lovbraaten, they moved to ND and had these children: Tilla, Gina and Bernt. No death records for them. Borger and Kari's other children: Ole, b. Jan. 1, 1845, died Nov. 17, 1929 in Spring Grove, have information about his family; Iver, b. Dec. 13, 1846, emigrated 1869, no information; Karen, b. July 3, 1849, emigrated 1874, married to Peder Hansen, b. Jan. 20, 1832 at Strande in West part of Brandbu. They lived in Callendar, IA. Maria was the aunt of Peter, Iver, Ole and Hans P. Kammerude, see forms 105-107. Ole Johannesen was married the first time 1846 in Toten to Helene Gulbrandsdatter who died 1863 in Gran. Ole and Helene's children:

Feb. 29, 1826 in Jevnaker, emigrated 1871, his mother, Malene Olsdatter, b. Jan. 6, 1815 at Skirstadeiet in Gran and their son Andreas, b. Dec. 30, 1859, emigrated 1873.
2. Johanne Maria, b. Jan. 8, 1849 in W. Toten, emigrated 1870 together with Gulbrand Paulsen, b. Nov. 24, 1844 at Hvalebyeiet in Gran. Married in US?
3. Gustav, b. June 16, 1853 in W. Toten, emigrated 1872. Married to Birthe Christiansdatter, b. Apr. 8, 1855 at Hvalebyeiet, emigrated 1869. Gustav and Birthe lived different places in WI and IA, but latest in Green Co., WI. They had 11 children, we have their names. Birthe's parents, Christian Andersen, b. about 1824 and Maria Nilsdatter, b. about 1831, emigrated 1868 with their daughter, Helene Maria, b. Sept. 10, 1857 at Hvalebyeiet. The daughter, Andrine, b. Dec. 29, 1851 at Horgeneiet in Gran, emigrated 1869. 4. Ole, b. Jun. 24, 1855 in W. Toten, emigrated 1876. 5. Birthe Helene, b. Oct. 1, 1860, emigrated 1883.

Family 287, form 508: Paul Paulsen Welo, b. Oct. 12, 1861 at Velo in Jevnaker, emigrated 1888, lived in Hatton, ND and St. Paul, MN. We have information about him. Paul had 3 siblings who emigrated:

1. Mari, b. Nov. 13, 1847, died 1936 in WA, see form 968;
2. Iver, b. May, 28, 1855, emigrated 1888 and
3. Hans, b. Sept. 16, 1857, emigrated 1882 to Rothsay, MN. No information about Iver or Hans.

Dec. 13, 1842 at Vieneiet in Gran and daughter, Julie, b. Aug. 16, 1866 at Vieneiet. No information about them. Martin's parents were not married. His mother, Gjertrud Gulbrandsdatter, b. Nov. 1, 1817 at Lundereiet in Lunner, emigrated 1871 with Martin's half-sister, Karen Teodorsdatter, b. Sept. 13, 1861 at Lundereiet. Karen married Erik Andersen Blilie, b. Oct. 22, 1856. Karen and Erik buried

in Kindred, ND, see form 25. Martin's father, Engebret Larsen, b. Aug. 28, 1818, see form 1079.

Family 289, form 513: Ole Gulbrandsen Melaas, b. March 18, 1821 in Lunner, emigrated 1869 with his second wife, Anne Helgesdatter, b. Feb. 21, 1835 at Rya in Lunner and Ole's children from his first marriage: 1. Ragnild, b. Aug. 29, 1852, 2. Gulbrand, b. Feb. 8, 1855, 3. Carine, b. Oct. 3, 1857, 4. Karen, b. Dec. 25, 1859 and 5. Gudmund, b. Mar. 31, 1862. Their mother was Lise Marie Gulbrandsdatter Haga who died 1865 in Lunnet They first settled in Winneshiek Co., IA, later in Heron Lake, Jackson Co., MN. Ole died 1900 and Anne died 1901 in Storden, MN.

Ragnild married first time 1877 to Anders Iversen, second time to Colben Jacobsen. She died Sept. 24, 1937, missing place.

Gulbrand married to Anna Nomeland. They lived in Heron Lake in 1935, no death records.

Carine married first time to Peder Jacobsen, second time to Abel Kyllingstad. She died 1935 in Minneapolis.

Karen married to Paul Engebretsen Bilden. She died July 26, 1944 in Northwood, ND.

Gudmund's wife was Etta, missing death records. We also are missing records for the grandchildren of Ole and Lise Marie. Ole's brother, Hans Gulbrandsen, b. Nov. 24 1824, emigrated 1853. No information about him.

Ole's sister, Kari, b. July 2, 1829 at Melaas, emigrated 1868 with husband Martin Paulsen, b. about 1829 in Toten and children: 1. Mathilde, b. July 18, 1858, 2. Gustav, b. Oct. 4, 1859, 3. Peder, b. June 8, 1861, 4. Randi. b. Feb. 26, 1863 and 5. Edvard, b. June 21, 1865, all born at Sløviken in Jevnaker. No information about this family.

Family 290, form 517: Maren Nilsdatter, b. Sept. 16, 1861 at Raastad in Gran, emigrated 1888 with husband Karl Ludvig Petersen, b. 1860 in Oslo and their son, Nils Peter, b. Aug. 13, 1887 at Tingelstadeiet. Two more children born in US, Gilbert and Clara. Karl Ludvig left the family and they never heard from him. Maren died Feb. 7, 1945 in WI, no death record for Nils Peter. Also Maren's sister, Kari, b. Nov. 3, 1855 at Lynneeiet in Gran, emigrated 1888, no information about her.

Family 291, form 518: Iver Jacobsen, b. 1791 at Rakeneiet in Brandbu, emigrated as a widower 1853 with 5 children: Maria. b. Nov. 29, 1830, Juel, b. Apr. 21, 1834 and Ole, b. Jan. 11, 1837, all born at Ammundrudeiet in Tingelstad. They first lived in Chicago, from 1855 in Lake Koshkonong, then in Scott Co., MN and from 1879 in Barnesville, Clay Co., MN. Also Iver's daughter, Kirsti, b. Jan. 16, 1825, emigrated with her husband Christen Andersen, b. Jan. 13, 1828 at Berven in W. Brandbu. They both died in Clay Co., MN.

Iver's daughter, Anne, b. Oct. 15, 1827 emigrated with her husband, Jens Larsen, b. Mar. 20, 1821 at Røkeneiet and their son Lars, b. July 19, 1851. Jens died in Chicago in 1855, no information about Anne and Lars.

Jens Larsen's brother, Anders, b. May 31, 1826 at Røkeneiet, emigrated too. He married Iver's daughter Maria. Maria died 1875 in Scott Co., Anders died 1921 in Barnesville. Maria and Anders had 3 children born in US, their son, Ole, b. Apr. 16, 1867 in Scott Co., MN, married Karoline Pedersdatter, b. Dec. 26. 1880 at Sanbeckløggen in Brandbu. Karoline emigrated 1881 with her parents, Peder Gulbrandsen, b. Sept. 10, 1851 at Eggeeiet and Birthe Johansdatter, b. Jun. 7, 1850 at Nesteggeeiet in Brandbu. Ole died 1940 in Clay Co., Birthe died 1937 in Hawley, MN, no death records for Karoline and her father, Peder.

Juel died 1863 in Dakota Co., MN, Ole died 1865 in the Civil War.

Iver Jacobsen's son, Jacob, stayed in Norway and married Goro Steengrimsdatter from Hallingdal. Their son, Iver, b. Oct. 19, 1849 at Amundrudeiet, emigrated 1878 to Rushford, MN with wife Anne Marie Hansdatter, b. Nov.23, 1858 at Røisumseiet in Tingelstad and their daughters: Gina b. Jun. 24, 1875 and Anne. b. Jan, 25, 1877. No information about the family

from the US. We are missing Iver Jacobsen's death records.

Family 292, form 532 and 533: Iver Andersen Holter, b. 1804 at Almseiet in Tingelstad, emigrated 1862 with his wife, Susanne Torstensdatter, b. 1795 at Sørumsøiet in Tingelstad. Iver died 1890 in Brighton Twp., Nicollet Co., MN, no death record for Susanne. Their son, Halvor, b. Feb. 22, 1837 at Holter, emigrated 1861 with wife Anne Gulbrandsdatter, b. Jan. 9, 1830 at Raastad in Gran and children: Ingeborg, b. Dec. 25, 1837 and Susanna, b. Sept. 26, 1860, both born at Raastad in Gran. We have records for this family, see form 533.

Susanne was married the first time to Halvor Johnsen Holter, who died in 1833. Their daughter, Mari, b. Dec. 11, 1826 at Holter, emigrated 1861 with husband Anders Pedersen, b. Feb. 9, 1820 at Svensbakken in Brandbu and their children: Anne, b. Nov. 10, 1846, Marthe, b. Dec. 19, 1850, Susanna, b. May 31, 1853, Pernille, b. Mar. 18, 1855, Halvor, b. May, 6, 1857 and Kari, born Jan 29, 1860. They first lived in WI where they had two more children: Nicolette Maria, b. 1864 and Bertha, b. 1866. Then they went to MN where son John was born in 1868. Mari died about 1911, Anders died about 1878, buried in Nicollet Co. No information about their children from US.
